ABSTRACT

AI and especially GAI has overtaken the market, public opinion and tech policymaking by a storm. Omer will talk about legislative and regulatory responses to GAI, as well as how companies are preparing and responding to the new challenges. He will also discuss developments in privacy, focusing on health data and protection of kids.

Omer is a partner at Goodwin in the firm's technology group and its data, privacy and cybersecurity practice. He is also an affiliate scholar at the Stanford Center for Internet and Society and a senior fellow at the Future of Privacy Forum. He was appointed to the Arbitration Panel under the U.S.-EU Privacy Shield Agreement and was the Rapporteur for the 30-year review of the OECD Privacy Guidelines.

Prior to joining Goodwin, Tene was vice president and chief knowledge officer at the International Association of Privacy Professionals, the principal professional organization for privacy lawyers and professionals worldwide. He was the IAPP's leading subject matter expert and led the organization's creation and distribution of content, including its research, publications, programming, and external affairs.
